The First International Mikhail Bakhtin Conference, organized by Clive Thomson, Anthony Wall, and others, was held at Queen's University (Canada) in October, 1983. The thirteenth conference will be held as a celebration of the accomplishments of the twelve others that have taken place over the twenty-five years since the first one. More importantly, the thirteenth conference will be an occasion to assess the present state of research on the Bakhtin Circle and map out directions for future research.

Conference Themes: Papers and panel proposals on all aspects of the work of the Bakhtin Circle are welcome: genesis, influences, comparisons, reception, extensions, reformulations, exegesis, textology, translation, teaching, etc.

Le premier congrès international Mikhaïl Bakhtine, organisé par Clive Thomson, Anthony Wall et d'autres collaborateurs, eut lieu au Canada en octobre 1983, à l'université Queen's (Kingston). En 2008, le treizième congrès Bakhtine sera la célébration des travaux accomplis lors des onze congrès organisés pendant les vingt-cinq ans qui suivirent le congrès inaugural. De surcroît, le treizième congrès sera l'occasion d'évaluer l'état présent des recherches sur le cercle Bakhtine et d'explorer quelques pistes pour l'avenir de ces recherches.
